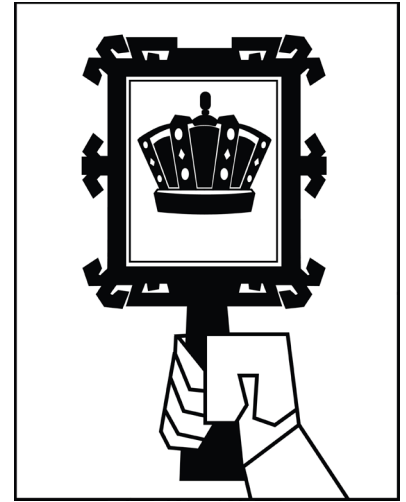


DEADLY SE7EN

Monday

Proverbs 11:2 When arrogance comes, disgrace follows, but with humility comes wisdom.

A proud man is always looking down on things and people; and, of course, as long as you're looking down, you can't see something that's above you. – C.S. Lewis

How does displaying humility at work or school effect making good Godly choices in that environment?

Tuesday

But he gives more grace. Therefore it says, "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." James 4:6

Wednesday
